Firstly your comments on the assumptions and aims of the lesson are well thought out and appropriate for the level of the class. You have correctly noted that the first step is not beneficial for an elementary class and the new grammar should be approached in a step by step fashion. Your suggestions for concept questions in step two are good, however the picture is mentioned in the original lesson plan and we could assume it would be provided by the teacher. You correctly alter the fact that the teacher does not observe from the doorway in step five, instead closely monitoring the students. And providing the script for the listening in step six would as you rightly put it, change and reduce the efficiency of the listening, well done. I agree that the multiple choice activity in step ten is rather bland and would not sit well at this stage of the lesson, your suggestion that lessons should end on a 'high note' is an excellent observation. The homework stage has also been improved and you are aware that the original lesson was too general and that the students need a focus and a purpose to write.

This is an excellent analysis of the original lesson plan, with perceptive alternatives for the weak areas. Well done.
